



Statement from Knowledge Alliance on the passage of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 Labor, Health and Human Services, Education and Related Agencies (LHHS) appropriations bill by the House of Representatives:

Knowledge Alliance, a nationwide coalition of leading education organizations, released the following statement in response to passage of the FY26 LHHS appropriations bill by the House of Representatives:

“From the beginning of the Fiscal Year 2026 (FY26) appropriations process, Knowledge Alliance has advocated for robust funding for Federal education research, development, and dissemination (RD&D) and technical assistance. Funding that would allow the Federal government to build on what works and continue innovating to meet the needs of states, districts, and schools across the country. We are encouraged by the bipartisan commitment to education RD&D and technical assistance funding in the FY26 Labor, Health and Human Services, and Related Agencies appropriations bill recently passed by the U.S. House of Representatives. The resources included in the authorizing legislation, including for critical priorities like Regional Education Laboratories and Comprehensive Centers, create a pathway for the Administration to continue the work of strengthening Federal RD&D and technical assistance while simultaneously supporting effective partnerships with state and local education agencies to improve outcomes for students, educators, and families. We look forward to working with our member organizations, the Department of Education, and other relevant agencies to ensure effective implementation of this funding that builds on proven approaches and supports new efforts to improve education for every student.”
